Israel's Apostacy according to Scripture

- Numbers 25: Israel enticed by Moabites to Baal worship (cf. Ps 106:28)
- Judg 6: Gideon tears down the altar of Baal
- 1 Kings 16–18: Jezebel, Elijah against the prophets of Baal and Asherah
- Numerous kings of Israel (e.g., Ahaziah in 22:53)
- Judahites make child sacrifices to Baal (Jer 19:5) and Molech (Jer 32:35)
- Asa's mother worships Asherah (1 Kgs 15:13)
- Manasseh put an image of Asherah in the temple of Jerusalem (2 Kgs 21:7)
- Many, many others

BaalCanaanite Storm Deity

- Rain-giver
- Voice = thunder
- Depicted as a warrior holding a lightning bolt
- Associated with yām "sea," a deity of chaos




BaalCanaanite Storm Deity

- Associated with *yām* "sea," a deity of chaos




Asherah Fertility goddess

- Commonly found alongside Baal in the Bible
- Most biblical references speak of a kind of Asherah pole/pillar/tree set up beside altars to male deities
- Dozens of "pillar figurines" found, every archaeological period (image to right)

YHWH and His Asherah? 8th c. Tomb Inscription

Uryahu, the wealthy man, had it written: Blessed be Uryahu by YHWH And from his enemies, O Asherah, save him.

or perhaps

Uriyahu the prince wrote it: Blessed be Uriyahu by Yahweh and his Asherah, for from his enemies, he (Yahweh) saved him.




Figure 5.7 Kuntillet 'Ajrud pithos A: two scenes and an inscription (after Meshel, 1978: pl. 12, 15; 1993: 1462–3; Renz and Röllig, 1995 /III: taf. III, 1a, b).

Kuntillet 'Ajrud Inscriptions

I bless you by/to YHWH of Samaria and by/to Asherata.

Religion(s) of Ancient Israel and Judah Summary so far

- People in Israel/Judah were worshipping deities other than YHWH.
- Can't be certain how widespread this was. Kuntillet 'Ajrud is far from Jerusalem's oversight.
- At the same time, the OT acknowledges that worship of Baal and Asherah were ongoing issues, even in the temple in Jerusalem.
 - Manassah brought the Asherah fertility cult into the temple (2 Kgs 21:7).
 - Josiah destroyed the "houses" of cult prostitutes (2 Kgs 23:4–7).

Psalm 29

A PSALM OF DAVID.

- 1 Ascribe to the LORD, O heavenly beings, ascribe to the LORD glory and strength.
- 2 Ascribe to the LORD the glory due his name; worship the LORD in the splendor of holiness.
- 3 The voice of the LORD is over the waters; the God of glory thunders, the LORD, over many waters.
- 4 The voice of the LORD is powerful; the voice of the LORD is full of majesty.
- **5** The voice of the LORD breaks the cedars; the LORD breaks the cedars of Lebanon.
- 6 He makes Lebanon to skip like a calf, and Sirion like a young wild ox."

Psalm 29

- 7 The voice of the LORD flashes forth flames of fire.
- 8 The voice of the LORD shakes the wilderness; the LORD shakes the wilderness of Kadesh.
- **9** The voice of the LORD makes the deer give birth and strips the forests bare, and in his temple all cry, "Glory!"
- 10 The LORD sits enthroned over the flood; the LORD sits enthroned as king forever.

Ps 29 and the Baal Myth

- Once again, archaeology shines light on the world of the Bible
- Non-biblical ancient texts also provide a window into the biblical world.
- With the combination of texts and artifacts, we can arrive at a clearer understanding of what the biblical texts meant in their ancient contexts.
- Without knowledge of Baal myth, Psalm 29 is a lovely hymn of praise; in light of the Ugaritic myth, we can see that it *is* that, plus a courageous declaration of who the *real* deity is. Knowing that may encourage believers in our time.
