Rwandan Independence A Bloody Beginning

- 1959 First wave of genocide
 - Estimated 20 to 100 thousand Tutsis killed
 - 150 thousand Tutsis fled to neighboring countries
- 1962 Republic of Rwanda
 - Hutu rule

- Civil Unrest
- Propaganda
- President's plane was shot down on April 6
- April 6 July: 800,000 dead

- There is a need for theological training and discipleship






- Born in Gettysburg, PA

- Grew up in and around Greensboro.








